Flutriafol and Triadimefon down

THOSE who understand the risks of disease in their crop and don't want the stress of considering expensive post emergent applications of fungicide later in the season will be doing an in furrow treatment and applying fungicide to fertilizer.

The decision to use this cheap insurance becomes much easier when the products become even cheaper. Flutriafol when it's as low as \$13/l only costs \$5.20/ha.

Glyphosate myth

THERE is a myth believed by some that regular Glyphosate needs up to 6 hours before you can sow and other Glyphosate products like say PowerMax® you are able to sow sooner.

"This assertion is untrue", says independent consultant John Holmes. "In my practical experience all Glyphosate products are roughly the same in this respect."

"Ideally from time of application under good growing conditions with small weeds they should be left an hour with a bit more time if spraying late in the day or at night. More time should also be left before sowing if doing full cut."

"You can sow straight behind the sprayer but it's a bit like spraying at night with Glyphosate, it's not ideal. On larger weeds it might be advisable to leave up to several days before working to ensure a better seed bed."

"Rainfastness of Glyphosate is quite a different attribute. In my observations all Glyphosates, including PowerMax®, rainfastness is generally complete after about 6 hours".
