Fix Trifluralin resistant ryegrass.

If you have problems with ryegrass resistance to Trifluralin, Metolachlor is a cheap alternative to try. The photo (below) shows the effect of a Trifluralin/Metalachlor mix

where the control had 518 ryegrass plants per square metre. Trifluralin reduced that count by 82pc. Metolachlor reduced it by 43pc. A mix of both gave 97pc control!
